#### **FAFSA Eligibility**

Valid Social Security Number

U.S Citizen or Eligible Resident

High School Diploma or GED


Accepted for Enrollment in a Program (only for aid to be disbursed, can apply before admitted)


#### Financial Aid - FAFSA

#### **Quick Facts About FAFSA**

- 1 Create a FSA ID (fsaid.ed.gov)
- 2 Be aware of college priority deadlines
- 3 Never pay to get your FAFSA filled out It's FREE! (fafsa.gov)
- 4 You do not have to complete the FAFSA all at once save and update info later
- 5 Use the IRS data retrieval process for quicker completion
- 6 If you're dependent, per FAFSA, you must provide parental information







SAR

Be sure to review your SAR to make sure all of the information is correct.

Information will be sent to every college you listed on the FAFSA.

Expected Family Contribution (EFC) will be used for colleges to determine your financial aid package.

Your college may request additional information once they receive your SAR.

This process is called Verification. Be sure to get any information back to your college as soon as possible so it doesn't affect your award!

Your application is reviewed, and once completed by your college, you will receive an award letter.

Schools will use their Cost of Attendance (COA) and your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) to determine your financial aid package.

#### Financial Aid - Undocumented Students

#### Eligible for state-based aid if:

You are a resident of Texas

You complete the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA)

Your college accepts the TASFA


You submit SB1528, selective service registration (males), and parent tax return transcripts



Contact the Financial Aid office at the college you plan to attend for more information and/or requirements to apply.
